ver the past sixteen weeks our parish has worked really hard to realise the vision of Archbishop Nichols with regard to **Growing** in **Faith**. Almost everyone in the parish has been contacted so that the vision of **Growing in Faith** could be explained. The response that we have had so far has been phenomenal. Thank you.

What we have achieved already is very encouraging. Our parish goal was to raise a minimum of £240,000. However, because our needs are great, our challenge goal is to raise £350,000. To date, through the support of 112 gifts to the campaign, we have raised £253,523!

That means from now on 75% of everything we raise stays here in the parish. This money will help us re-order our church, provide educational facilities which all our parishioners can access and advance our work with young people.

The average gift in our parish is £10 per week. $\frac{3}{4}$ of our parishioners are pledging over five years and have ticked the gift aid box thus adding 25% to their gift.

Parishes like ours across the Diocese are receiving an average of 190-200 gifts and pledges. For us this means receiving an additional 85 gifts and pledges. I would welcome your support on this commitment weekend effort. Our success now will help us to secure our future and encourage and inspire others to get involved.

Do remember that a weekly gift of £4, (which is the price of a cup of coffee), over five years comes to £1040, if you pay tax you can Gift Aid your pledge and that would make your pledge worth £1,300.

So if 85 people could pledge the price of a cup of coffee every week we could raise £110,500. This money would be used to complete the refurbishment of our church, make our facilities available to all our parishioners, especially those with mobility issues and provide facilities for work with our young people.

I would ask that on this final commitment weekend, if you are able to, you make a commitment to **Growing in Faith**.
