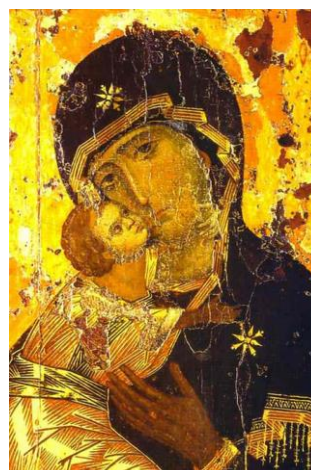

QUEEN OF HEAVEN, REJOICE!



May is closely associated with the veneration of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Mother of God is a key figure within salvation history and someone we hold in high esteem. 'The Virgin Mary most perfectly embodies the obedience of faith.....It is for this faith that all generations have called Mary blessed.' (*Catechism of the Catholic Church para 148*)

There are many ways to live out this devotion in our life. We can say the Holy Rosary; it is recited after each weekday Mass. Perhaps you could pray a decade as a family at some point in the week or place an image of Mary in a prominent place at home? The Liturgy of the Hours, which all religious and priests say at least five times a day, concludes with a Marian hymn. In Eastertime it is the ancient 'Regina Coeli' prayer. So, during May at each parish mass, after the final blessing, we will sing this hymn. The tune is easy enough to pick up!

Quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia,
Resurrexit, sicut dixit, alleluia:
