In 2000 at the Mass for the canonization of Saint Faustina Kowalska, Saint John Paul II proclaimed to the world that 'from now on throughout the Church this Sunday will be called Divine Mercy Sunday.'

Helena Kowalska was born in Poland in 1905 and in 1925 entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, taking the name Faustina. In 1931 she experienced a life-changing vision of Christ where she saw him wearing a white robe and raising his right hand in blessing with his left hand resting on his heart from which flowed two rays of light. Jesus told her to paint an image according to the pattern she saw with the prayer 'Jesus, I trust in you.' She recorded her visions in a diary and devoted the rest of her life to spreading the message of divine mercy and devotion to it.

The Divine Mercy devotion fosters trust in God's mercy that finds its fulfilment in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. As a 'personal revelation' it is not necessary to faith to accept St Faustina's revelations, yet such devotion makes participation in the sacraments more fruitful and is thus promoted across the Church.
